We ask you to plan your wardrobe accordingly by following this dress code:

- Hats, caps, and visors are not appropriate inside building and at meals.
- Shorts should be appropriate for school.

- See through shirts are not acceptable.
- No thong or bikini swimming pool area all youth must have a shirt on.
- All wardrobes are subject to approval of adults in charge.
